### The Missouri Show-Me Big Bucks Club Whitetail Deer Awards

The Missouri Show-Me Big Bucks Club Whitetail Deer Awards are presented to the largest and second largest typical and non-typical antlers taken and entered into the Missouri Show-Me Big Bucks Club from the prior hunting season. This year the awards are from the 2004 hunting season. This prestigious award is presented to:

#### Typical Entries

For the year 2004 there were 482 accepted entries into the Missouri Show-Me Big Bucks Club, 366 typical and 116 non-typical. The minimum for the Missouri Show-Me Big Bucks Club is 140 0/8 typical and 155 0/8 non-typical, state wide. To make the All-Time entry into the Boone & Crockett Club it takes 170 0/8 typical and 195 0/8 non-typical B&C inches. Antlers at 170 0/8 or larger typical and 195 0/8 or larger non-typical are referred to as All-Time entries. We had 13 All-Time typical entries and 12 All-Time non-typical entries. To make the 3 year Awards Period for Boone & Crockett Club the minimum entry is 160 0/8 typical and 185 0/8 non-typical. B&C has a 10 inch less minimum for this 3 year Awards Period for whitetail deer. Antlers that score 160 0/8 - 169 7/8 typical and 185 0/8 - 194 7/8 non-typical are referred to as Award Book entries. The Big Bucks Club had 34 Award Book typical entries and 7 Award Book non-typical entries. A total of 65 B&C potential entries. Note: Not all eligible entries entered into the Missouri Show-Me Big Bucks Club that score the Boone & Crockett minimums are entered into the Boone & Crockett Club. The Missouri Show-Me Big Bucks Club is a state wide organization, the Boone & Crockett Club is a national organization. The Missouri Show-Me Big Bucks Club has written permission from the Boone & Crockett Club to use the copyrighted Boone & Crockett Club measuring system. Accepted entries into the Missouri Show-Me Big Bucks Club may vary from those accepted by the Boone & Crockett Club.

## **R. Scott Brundage Award**

## **Missouri Show-Me Big Bucks Club Youth Award**

This award is presented to youth that have taken a whitetail deer from Missouri that has qualified for the Missouri Show-Me Big Bucks Club minimum entry of 140 0/8 typical or 155 0/8 non-typical from the last recording period. There are two age groups: 11 and under and 12 - 15 years of age. Youth do not have to be of the age above at the time of entry, but must be of that age at the time of harvesting the deer. This award is given to the top 5 entries typical and non-typical by weapon used that have been entered and accepted by the Missouri Show-Me Big Buck Club. Entry period is from January 1 through December 31 of each year.
