The Missouri Show-Me Big Bucks Club Records of Whitetail Deer Record Book

The All-Time Record Book first edition, hardback cover, was published in 1998, has 348 pages, over 300 photographs, artwork by nationally known artists, articles by professional outdoor writers, club records listed by county and state ranking. First records book of this type ever done on Whitetail Deer from Missouri. This first edition book covers all entries and materials up to September 1997. Future publications of this hardback book will be done if public support and financing is available.

The Records Manual

This soft cover bound book will be printed each year with current listings of the Missouri Show-Me Big Bucks Club records. This book will be in a series of books that was started in the year 2000. Each book will have the year printed on its front cover for that year. This will provide an up-to-date listing of club records every year. (Currently all records are available on MSMBBC web site.) (No available printer at this time.)

The Top 50 Records Program

The top 50 program was designed to recognize accepted entries in the Missouri Show-Me Big Bucks Club that have unique qualities within the frame work of the Boone & Crockett Club measuring system. This is done by taking individual measurements like length of main beams, G-points lengths, etc. The top 50 is listed by weapons used in the harvesting of deer, like High-Powered Rifle (PH/RIFLE), Bow (Bow), Muzzleloader (M/L), Pistol (pistol), and Hunting Method Exemption Bow (HME). The quality of the measurements listed are world class measurements. The Top 50 Records Program will be available on the Missouri Show-Me Big Bucks Club web site only.

The Missouri Show-Me Big Bucks Club Hunting Journal on the Web

Publication yearly that will provide a wide range of information on hunting deer in Missouri. It will contain photos and hunting stories from club members. Articles from outdoor writers from across Missouri.. (On MSMBBC web site only.)

The R. Scott Brundage Award

This award is given to the top 5 Typical & Non-Typical Whitetail Deer entered by the following weapons; High-Powered Rifle, Bow & Arrow, Muzzleloader, Pistol, and HME Bow. Awards are presented to trophies taken from any season, but must be entered in the given year established for awards. To be eligible to receive this award you must have entered your deer antler into the Big Bucks Club between January 1 through December 31, each year. This certificate is to recognize trophy excellence of Whitetail Deer Antlers taken in Missouri.

The Master Hunter Award

This award is presented to club members of the Missouri Show-Me Big Bucks Club that have accomplished a higher standard than anyone else in the Big Bucks Club. A Master Hunter must have knowledge and hunting skills beyond the average hunter to attain this level of hunting excellence. To be eligible for the Master Hunter Award you must have taken and entered 400 Boone & Crockett net inches. For Senior Master Hunter Award you must have taken 800 Boone & Crockett net inches. For Supreme Master Hunter you must have taken 1200 Boone & Crockett net inches. Honorary Master Hunter, is a hunter that has entered 2 entries into the Big Bucks Club, are listed but receive no certificate.

The Missouri Show-Me Big Bucks Club Whitetail Deer Award

This award (an oak plaque, outline of Missouri, with black brass plating & gold lettering) is presented to the hunters that have taken the largest and second largest Typical and Non-Typical Whitetail Deer from Missouri, from the prior hunting season, which have been entered and accepted into the Missouri Show-Me Big Bucks Club.

The Missouri Show-Me Big Bucks Club Shed Antler Award

This certificate is presented to hunters that have entered the two largest typical and nontypical, right and left, shed antlers into the Big Bucks Club from January 1 through December 31 each year. The shed antler logo is by Wildlife Artists **Robert Probasco**, designed exclusively for the Missouri Show-Me Big Bucks Club.

The Missouri Show-Me Big Bucks Club Youth Award

This certificate is presented to the first and second place typical and non-typical by weapon used, High-Powered Rifle, Bow and Arrow, Muzzleloader, Pistol, and Hunting Method Exemption Bow. There are two age groups: 11 and under, and 12 to 15 years of age. To be eligible you must have taken a set of antlers that qualify for the club's minimum of 140 typical or 155 non-typical. Entries are eligible from January 1 to December 31 of each year. Youths do not have to be of the age above at the time of entry, but, must be of that age at the time of harvesting the deer. Eligible youth must indicate their age in the remarks section at the time they took their trophy on the official Boone and Crockett score form.

The Missouri Show-Me Big Bucks Club logo was designed by Wildlife Artists **Charles Schwartz**

Only antlers or shed antlers from free ranging Whitetail Deer in Missouri that have been entered and accepted by the Missouri Show-Me Big Bucks Club are eligible for awards.
